Fire Safe Coordinator Role

Educate, encourage, and develop county-wide collaboration and coordination amongst wildfire mitigation groups:

1. **Build census** of active wildfire mitigation groups
2. **Analyze gaps** in county-wide wildfire resiliency and emergency preparedness, and **develop recommendations**
3. Develop mechanism to **improve outreach and coordination**





Work Plan **Main Tasks**

- **Support** local Fire Safe groups (currently there are three)
- **Host and attend** regular meetings
- **Track** activities of local groups
- **Source and Recommend** Grants
- **Attend** meetings with the State Fire Safe Council



Tasks Completed



- 19 tasks over a two year period
- All tasks completed as of this month!
- Grant funds exhausted as of DECEMBER 31, 2024
- Program established (website, GIS map, tracking system, contacts, reporting, etc.)



Next Steps

- ALL DEPENDENT ON FUTURE FUNDING!
- **More outreach** to Fire Districts (volunteer/part time) Resource Conservation Districts (RCD's) and HOA groups on wildland Fire Mitigation and Preparedness
- Give away **Kits for preparedness fairs** (tabling Kits with instructions and all tools)
- **Apply for more funds** from the State
- **Continued regular communications** with local groups and state
